The best time to visit Madrid is during Spring and Autumn months. Autumns are mild in Madrid with a significant rise in rainfall. In September and October, we still enjoy warm and moderate temperatures, for that reason a lot of visitors come to Madrid at this time.

The average daytime temperature is 19.4 in October which lowers to 10.7 during night time.
